Kharkiv has a worldwide network of cultural and economic relations; this is reflected in the student body of the university.






to all world standards, giving an opportunity to get qualification of different professional levels from Bachelor to Doctor of medicine.

Ukraine's second biggest city doesn't look provincial, and for good reason: for over 15 years, from 1919 to 1934, it was Ukrainian capital. That's one of the reasons why Kharkiv's scientific and cultural levels are so high (as well as its industrial level, too). The city, in fact, is famous for its educational institutions.

Kharkiv's climate is humid continental with cold and snowy winters, and hot summers. The seasonal average temperatures are not too cold in winter, not too hot in summer: -6.9 °C (19.6 °F) in January, and +20.3 °C (68.54 °F) in July. The average rainfall totals 513 mm (20 in) per year, with the most in June and July.

The old center of Kharkiv is located around University Hill, named for the Kharkiv Imperial University, which started life in 1805 (today it's known as the Kharkiv National University). The city also boasts the Kharkiv Polytechnic Institute, the Kharkiv National University of Radio electronics and other educational institutions. In addition to the 45 universities there are also 60 scientific research institutions, 16 museums, the city art gallery, six public theaters, 80 libraries and the country's oldest observatoryin Kharkiv. Such are the facts that confirm Kharkiv's status as Ukraine's academic and scientific capital.
